

CSU/EPA Internship FAQs

- 1. Is this a paid internship?**
 - a. No, this is a for-credit internship only. You are not prevented from obtaining your own funding however.
- 2. Is there a difference in course requirements for undergraduates versus graduate students?**
 - a. No, all requirements are the same.
- 3. Can I do this internship without enrolling for course credit?**
 - a. No, the student should be enrolled for course credit.
- 4. Can I overload to do this internship?**
 - a. Please work with your academic advisor to determine the feasibility of course overload as it relates to this internship.
- 5. Can I enroll for 2 quarters/semesters for credit?**
 - a. Please work with your academic advisor to determine the feasibility of this as it relates to this internship.
- 6. I did the internship last quarter/semester. Can I get credit next quarter for it?**
 - a. No. There is no retroactive credit attainment for work done in the past.
- 7. How do I find a faculty advisor?**
 - a. The faculty advisor will be driven by the course selected for internship credit. Each course will have its own syllabus, faculty advisor and requirements – in addition to any requirements of the WRPI.
- 8. How soon should I start the process?**
 - a. You should apply and submit the required documents at least the quarter before you are able to enroll for course credit.
- 9. Can a Learning Project Plan required by the syllabus be substituted for the one required by the WRPI?**
 - a. No, WRPI's Learning Project Plan must be utilized.
- 10. Can a Final Report required by the syllabus be substituted for the one required by the WRPI?**
 - a. There is a possibility, but please contact WRPI for prior approval.
- 11. If I'm not selected to work on an internship, can I reapply next quarter?**
 - a. Yes.
- 12. Can I apply for more than one internship at a time?**
 - a. Yes.

13. Is this a paid internship?

14. Do I need to be a US citizen?

15. Does my work status matter?

a. No, however, if you do not hold a green card, the student VISA you are on must allow you to work (even for no pay).
