The deadline to submit your 2008-2009 CSUSB Scholarship has been extended until 5:00 pm Friday, March 7, 2008. Priority consideration will be given to students who submitted their applications by the first deadline of March 3, 2008.

Requirements

Scholarship funds can be used to meet the cost of education -- fees, books, expenses, room and board -- for students that meet the following scholarship criteria:

- * Be enrolled full-time in a undergraduate or graduate program at CSUSB;
 - * Demonstrate scholarly achievement in water resources evidenced by coursework, internship or special project;
 - * Possess a G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher;
 - * Demonstrate an interest to continue education beyond a Master's degree;
 - * Priority given for financial need and to students with historically disadvantaged backgrounds.
 - * In some cases, students must reside in a specific geographic area specified by donors. The Financial Aid Department will determine the eligibility of applicants.
