The WRI Advisory Board selected CALFED Director Joseph Grindstaff as the 2008 recipient of the Lifetime Achievement Award. Mr. Grindstaff was appointed Director of the CALFED Bay-Delta Program on June 12, 2006 by Gov. Arnold Schwarzenegger, after serving as acting director for the prior year. Prior to joining CALFED, he served as chief deputy director of the Department of Water Resources and general manager of the Santa Ana Watershed Project Authority. Earlier in his career, he served in leadership roles at other water districts and municipalities.
